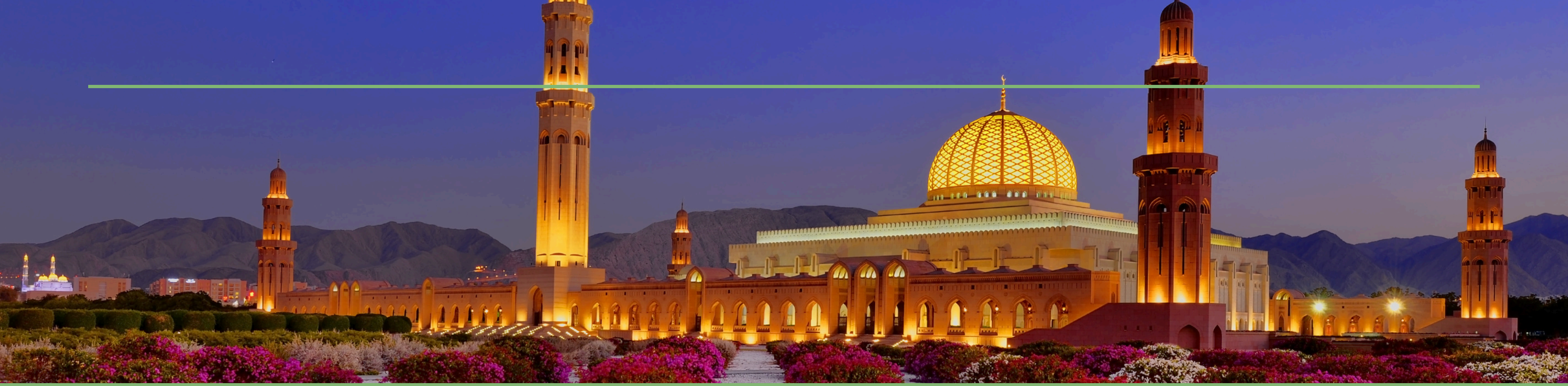
ADJUSTING TO OMAN'S ENVIRONMENT

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COFFEE & HALWA



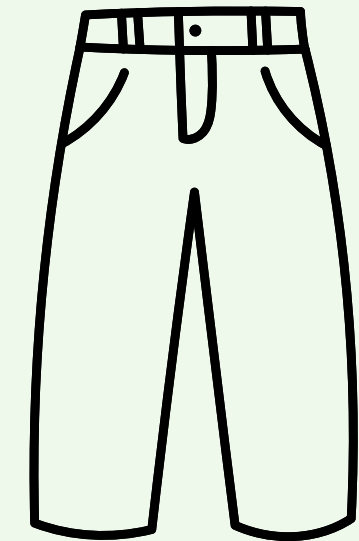
Accept invitations for Arabic coffee (qahwa) & Halwa as a gesture of friendship.
