



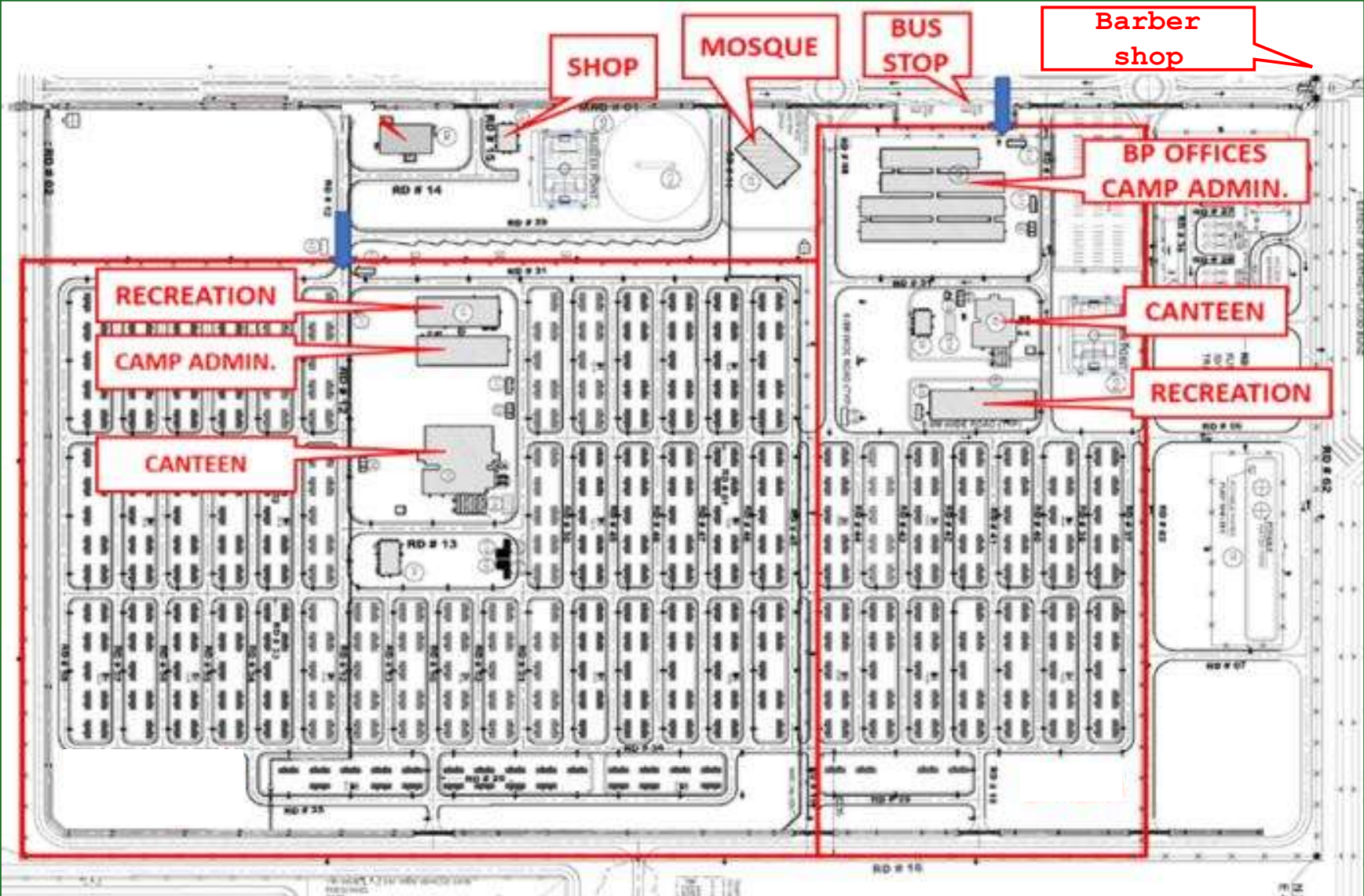

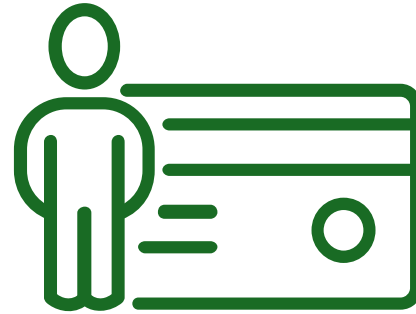

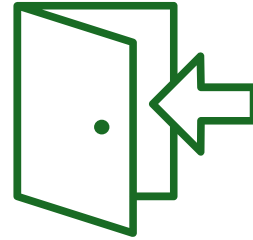
Reception & Access ID

Cards



1. 'Check-in' at reception upon arrival.
2. On each rotation or leave period, you are required to 'check-out' at the reception prior to departure.
3. Return your room key and T-card to the reception during check-out.
4. Visitors will be issued a visitor's ID card and long term residents will be issued a photo ID card.
5. Visitor ID cards must be returned to reception prior to final departure.
6. In camp - your ID card is required for identification & for muster.
7. Report any lost card immediately to reception.





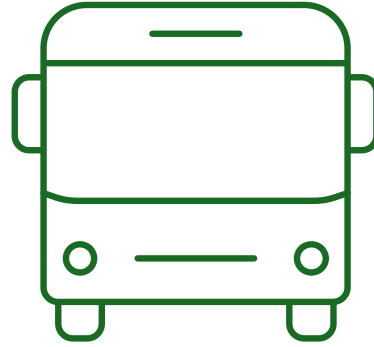
Camp In & Out

- **T Cards** are mounted at camp entrance just behind Security Shelter.
- Place your T Card In / Out while entering / exiting the camp gate.
- In an emergency, inaccuracy in T Cards will cause delays and place safety staff at risk as they search for individuals thought to be missing.
- Don't attempt to shortcut the system in any way, e.g. by exiting through a red emergency gate.





BP Bus Service

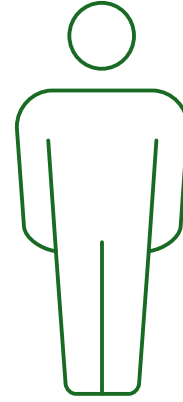


- Reservations must be made in advance of travel through Trobexis.
- Bus stop is located outside the KCC Reception Building.
- Saturday to Thursday **except Fridays**.
- Muscat Bus departs at 07:15 am.
- ETA at the NOVOTEL is 1:15 pm.
- Ibri Bus departs at 07:15 am.

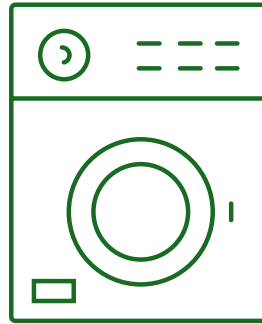

Laundry



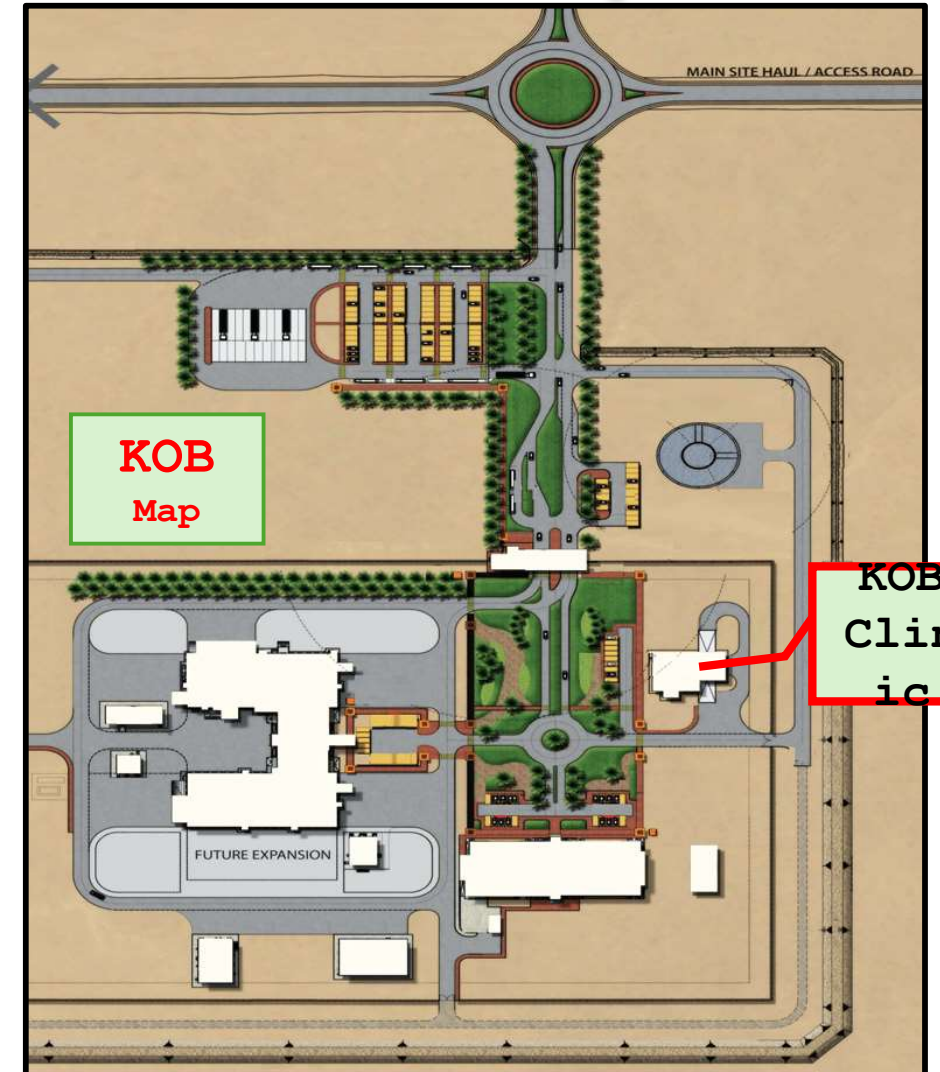
- Empty all pockets, Laundry will not be responsible for personal belongings
- Place all soiled clothes in the laundry bag provided in your room.
- Complete the 'Laundry List' form and place it inside the bag.
- We follow "No laundry slip, no wash policy"
- Leave the bag on the steps outside your room.
- Collection time for the laundry is between 6:00 - 7:00 am.
- Washed clothes will be returned within 24 hrs.



KOB Medical Clinic



- Upon arrival all permanent camp residents (photo ID Card holders) are required to register at KOB Clinic.
- Clinic timings- **6:30 am to 06:30 pm** daily.
- Female clinic staff on duty.
- In addition, an emergency doctor and ambulance are on stand-by 24 hrs.
- BP maintains a trained and equipped rescue team on permanent stand-by at the KOB.

- Defibrillators & First Aid Kits are placed in common areas.

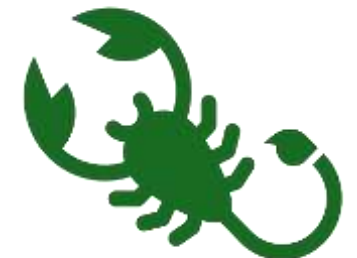


Basic First Aid incase of bite

IMMEDIATELY SEEK MEDICAL ATTENTION.

Call emergency number 2212222

- Stay calm. Identify the type of reptile if possible and do so safely.
- Keep still and calm. This can slow down the spread of venom.
- Do not pain killers or caffeinated drinks
- Do not apply chemicals and ointments
- Incase of spider bite, wash the bite area with soap and water or antiseptic.
- Monitor the symptoms of sever rash or difficulty in breathing.

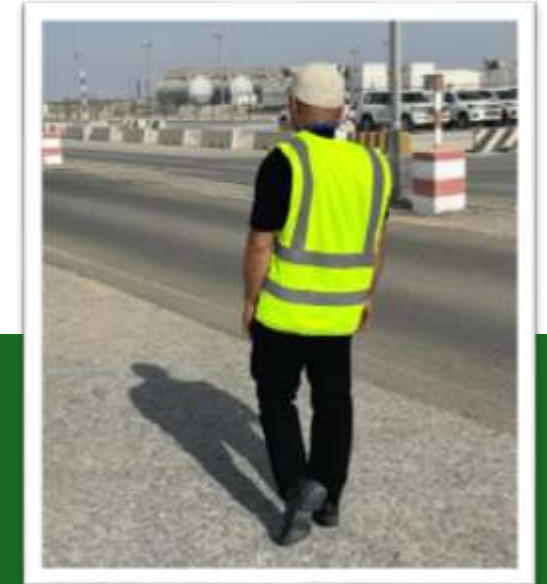




General Safety Guidelines



- Minimize to the lowest possible valuables when you are at site.
- Use Safety locker provided in the wardrobe.
- Always keep your wardrobe and your room locked.
- In case of lost or theft of any of your belonging, report immediately to Security.
- Never leave your bags / other belonging unattended or unsecured.
- If you have any security concern/ suspicion, report it to the security or call the emergency number:
Night Walking
 - **Walkers** must wear high-visibility vests provided by your employer while walking outside the camp .
 - Lone walking is not advised.
 - Walking on the blacktop is strictly prohibited.
 - Always walk in the opposite direction of moving vehicle.





Attack Alarm

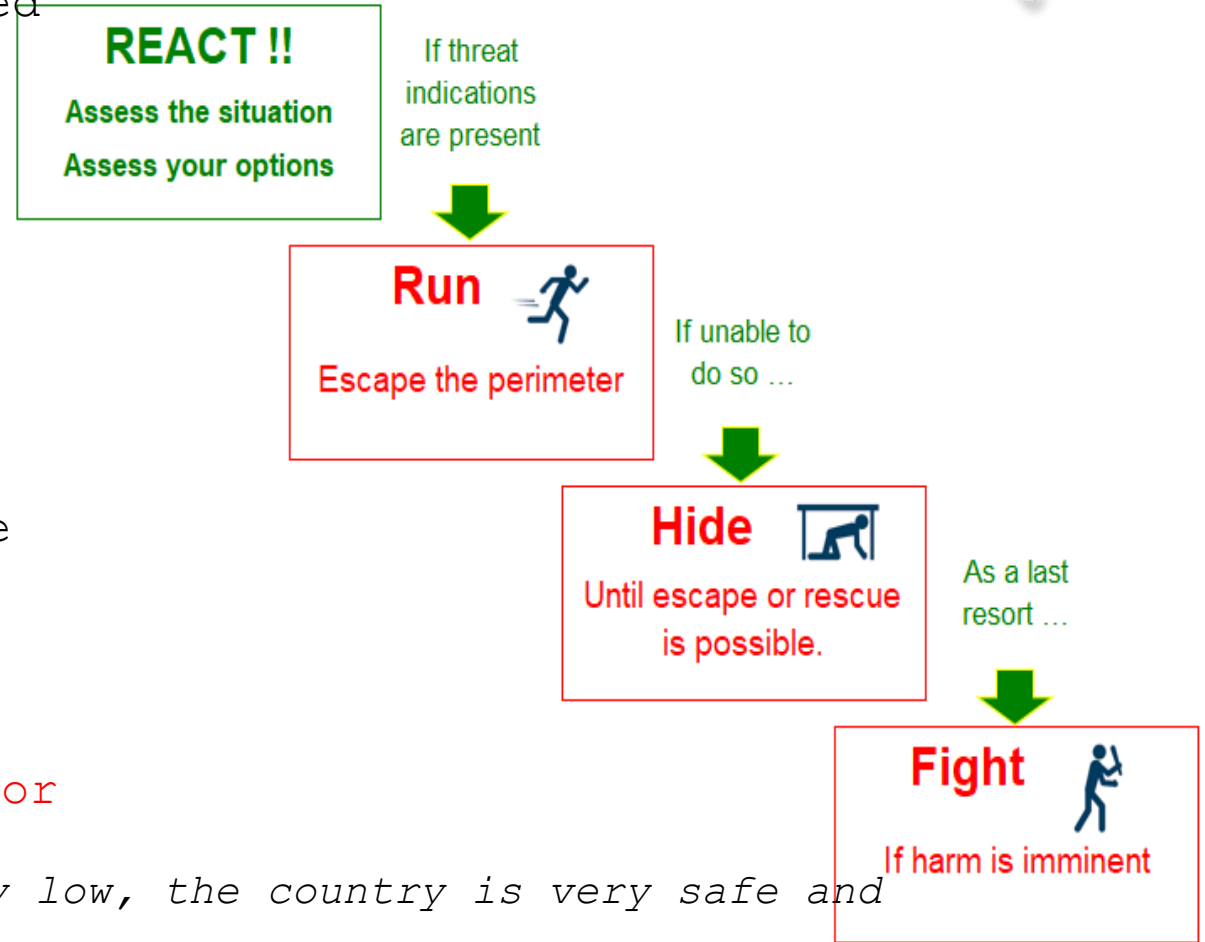


- An emergency attack alarm is installed within the camp in the form of a recorded message over the Public Announcement (PA) system.
- if activated, it may indicate an attack or serious security threat is imminent or underway unless it is false alarm.
- If you hear the alarm, or realise the camp is under attack
 - ✓ Do not go to the muster area!
 - ✓ Make your own judgement,

Hearing firearms/ explosives/ screaming or

Don't worry! the smell of gunpowder are common other

The likelihood of such attack in Oman is very low, the country is very safe and secure, indications of an attack.





Safety Guidelines for Portable Appliances in the Camp



- Residents should not use any portable appliance in the room without certification.
- Please contact Helpdesk to arrange Maintenance team for the Portable Appliance Testing (PAT) and sticker for certification If you got electronic appliance.
- Only 3-pin certified portable appliances can be used inside the accommodation room.

Note: Fire Alarm incidents already happened due to usage of 2-pin and not certified portable appliances.

Fire Alarm Mustering Procedure



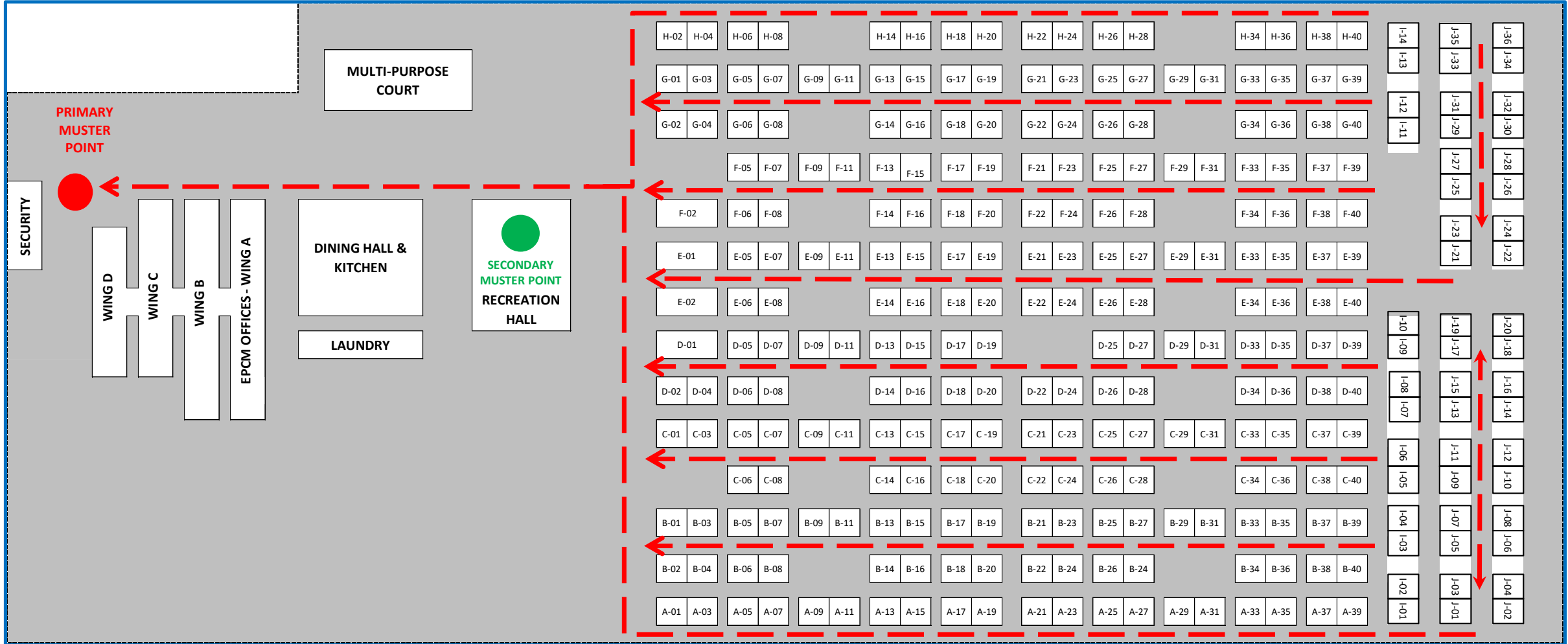
- When the fire alarm is activated move to the Muster point. (2-tone alarm with external red strobes)
- You will always go to the Primary Muster Point and will only move to the Secondary Muster Point if instructed to do so by a member of the ERT.
- There are two Muster Points located within the **Area-1** Camp:
 - **Primary** Muster Station - located next to the Guard House.
 - **Secondary** Muster Station - located inside the Recreation Bldg.
- Do not stop to collect personal belongings.
- On arrival at the Muster Point, place your t-card in the OUT rack and await further instructions.
- When the situation is confirmed safe, you will be required to move back your t-card from the OUT rack back to the IN rack.
- The Fire Safety Team will establish the source and cause of the activation.

Note: in Area-2

- The Fire alarm will activate only in the zone local to the source.
- Assemble at your nearest Muster Point for each row.

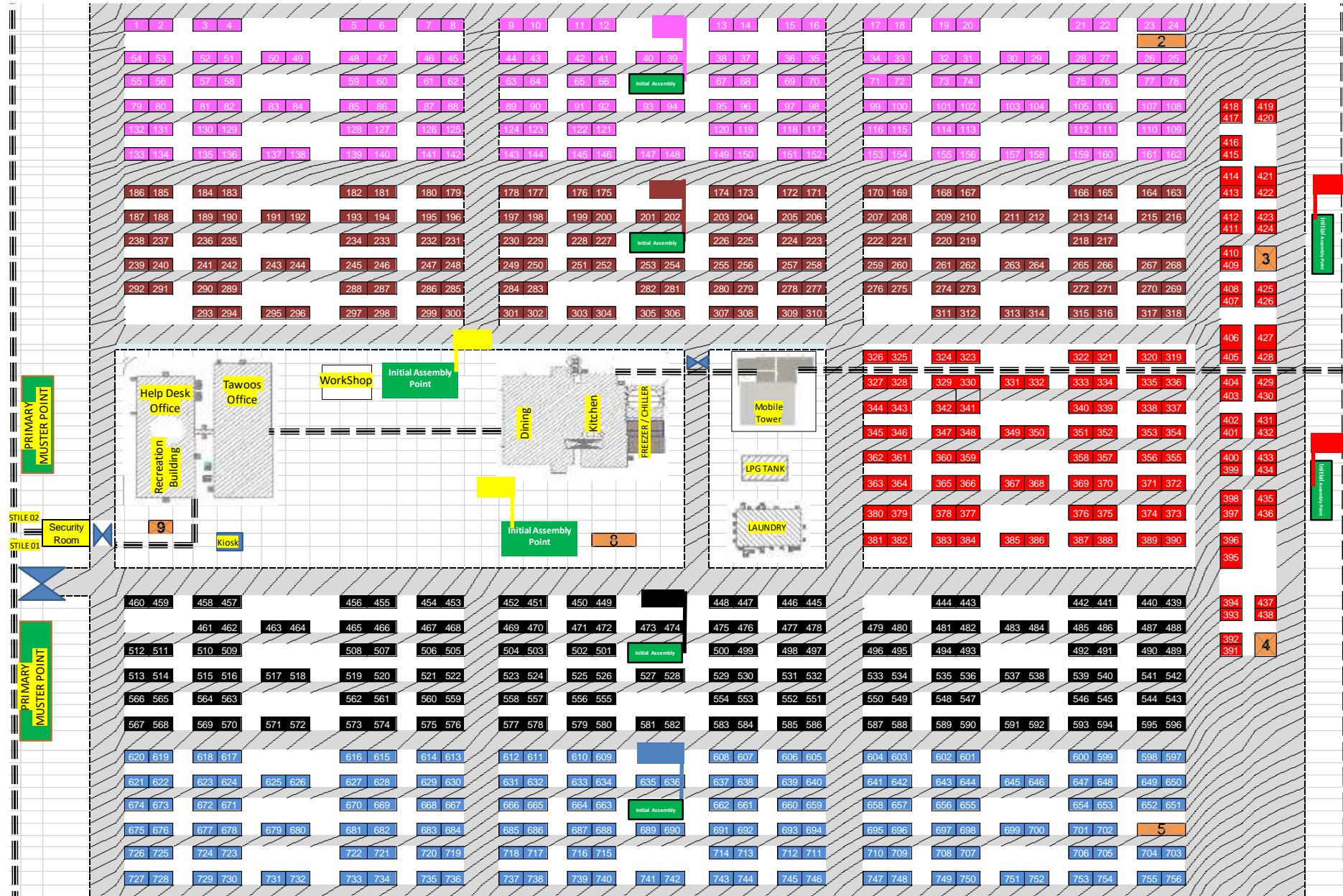


Area-1 Evacuation Plan

Mustering



- The activation will be investigated by our fire safety team.
- The alarm will continue to sound until the situation is confirmed safe.
- Do not re-enter the room or building until the alarm is silenced, to do so is a wilful breach of fire safety rules.
- A full camp muster may be instructed if fire is confirmed or in other emergency situations.
- Follow the instructions given by the Muster Controller. (you will be required to scan into a muster pen using your residents ID Card).
- If you are without your ID Card, inform the muster coordinator on arrival. Do not go back for it.



Below actions may cause fire alarm activation, therefore, kindly follow these rules in rooms

Keep the Kettle Lid closed while boiling, away from smoke detector

The fire alarm system identifies the source of any activation by room number. Residents found to have caused a fire alarm activation, by any of these violations, will be removed from Block #61.

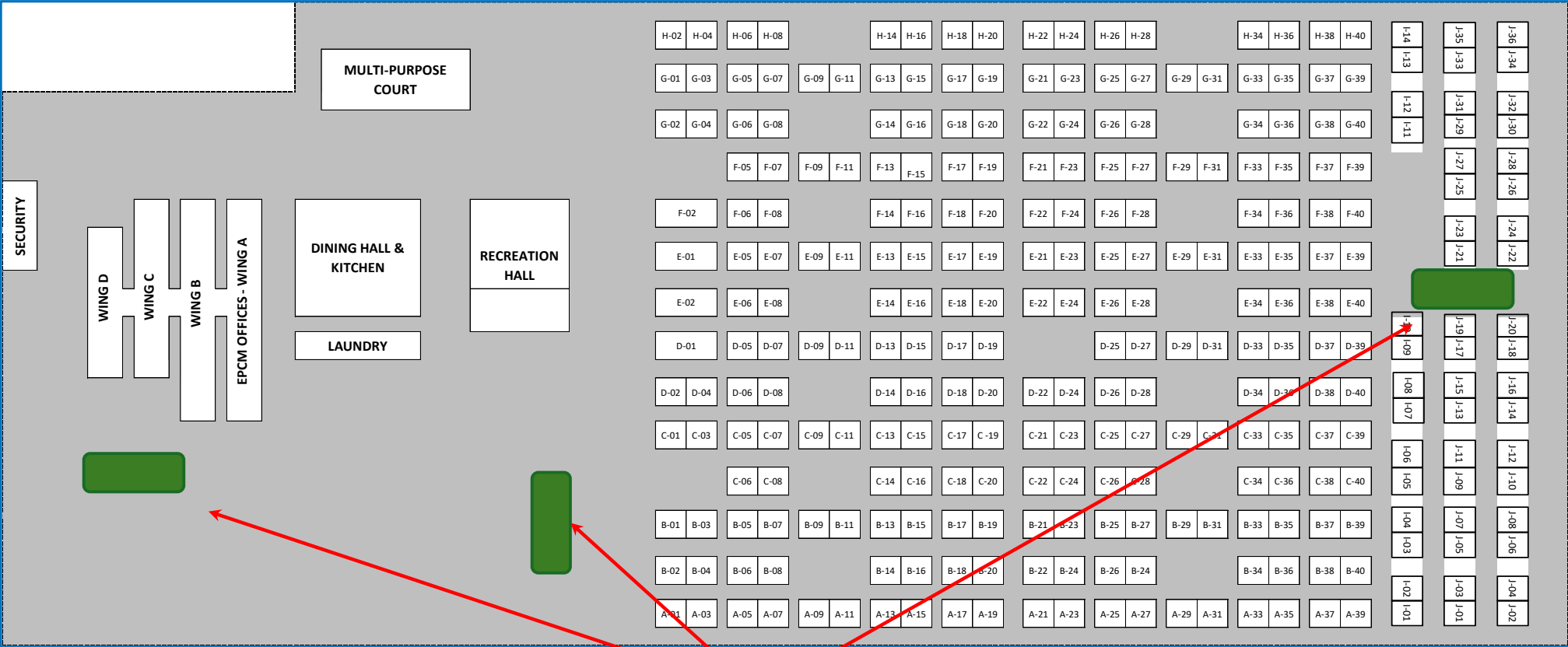

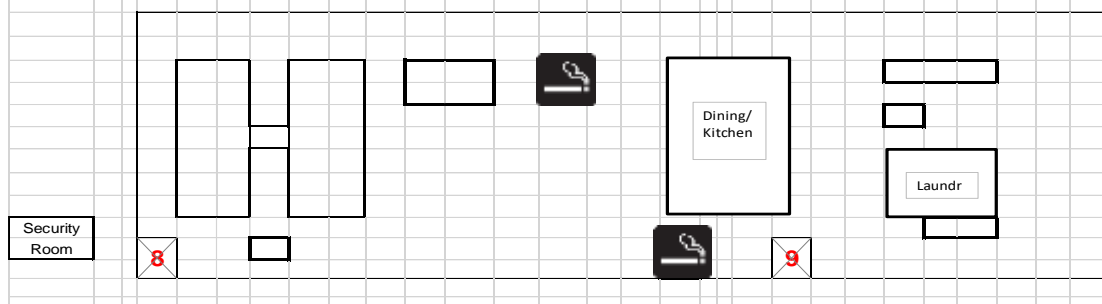

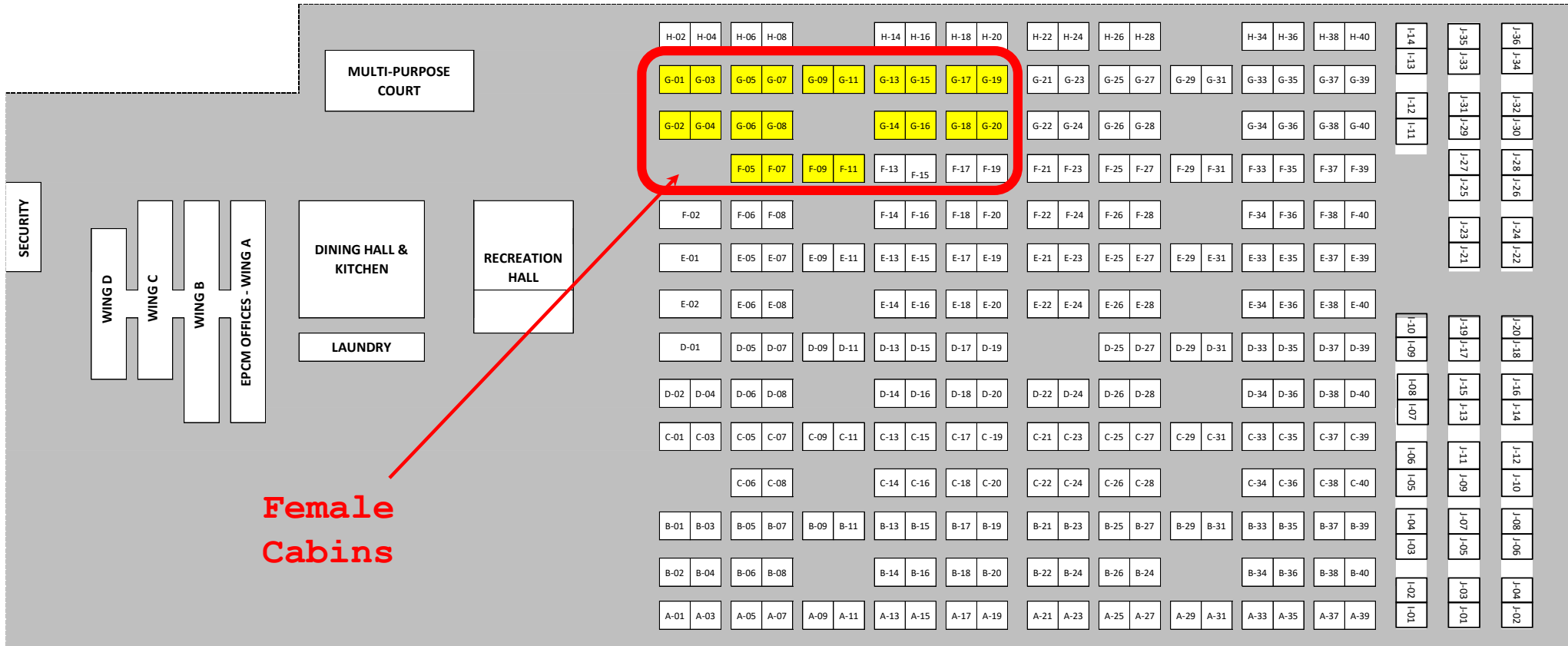
